

As this is my last message as pastor of Pulborough Brooks Baptist Church, I want to remind you of a few of things that I have tried to instil in the church over the past 8 and a half years. To begin with I want to remind you to always put God first: For He is the one who, through his love and faithfulness towards you, will make you holy. This is the purpose for which He has made each and every one of us; to be holy, as He is holy. Yes, I know it's a challenging call but that's because God doesn't want anything less than the best for His people.

Putting God first means putting your confidence in Him and trusting Him (Jer. 17:7-8) because of what He has done for you (Rom. 5:6-11). It means spending time with Him in prayer and immersing yourself in His word. That peace which passes all understanding (Phil 4:7) is only found at the throne of grace (Heb. 4:16) to which you have been given unlimited, unrestricted access, so use it!

Remember that the Word of God, which is "the sword of the Spirit" (Eph. 6:17), is no good if it's on your book shelf. It needs to be in your hand so that when the Holy Spirit activates its truth in your heart, it can convict you, instruct you, equip you, strengthen you, protect you and enable you to grow (2 Cor. 3:18).

And finally, look after one another. 'Encourage those who are timid. Take tender care of those who are weak. Try to do good to each other and be patient with everyone'. (1 Thes. 5:12-15)
