

Luke 6:27-42

We look this week at some of the teaching Jesus has given in the Sermon on the Mount. Not only did He teach with authority but the things He taught were revolutionary. What He said made people sit up in surprise and even shock. The truths and values of the Kingdom of God which Jesus taught, very often seemed completely opposite to the views and values of society. It is the same today in the 21st century. They are as revolutionary and life changing today as they were when He first spoke them to the listening crowds in Galilee.

For example, Jesus says 'love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.' Those who listened were familiar with the Old Testament teaching in Leviticus 19:18 to love your neighbour as yourself, but this was on another level.

As we look at these verses this morning, let's ask the Lord to put within us the kind of love that was in God when He sent His Son into the world that was full of God haters!
